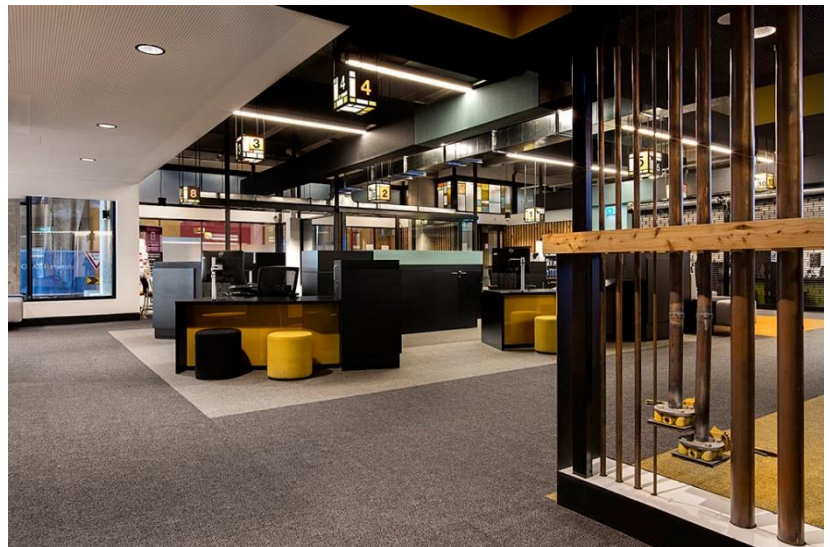

Monash University Caulfield Campus is 5.3 hectares in size and consists of 14 buildings and over 108,000 square meters gross floor area of building space area.

To accommodate the Caulfield Campus master planning and major redevelopment of Building A, various buildings across the campus had been decanted and re-fitted as a part of a work programme starting in 2013.
